Pre-fabricated turn-key housing units

1. The Government of Sint Maarten has received a Grant to execute the Emergency Debris Management Project (EDMP) from the Netherlands, administered by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (hereafter “the World Bank). The National Recovery Program Bureau has allocated part of the proceeds to the execution of the development of a Resettlement Action Plan in connection to scheduled activities at the Municipal Waste Disposal sites in Philipsburg, Sint Maarten
2. The National Recovery Program Bureau (NRPB) is requesting information to the market on the availability of types of adequate housing facilities that can be designed and built in a short time-frame. This includes, but is not limited to units such as container or other type of pre-fab houses.
3. The minimum required conditions and specifications are as follows:
 - a. Time-frame for turn-key delivery of housing units approximately 3 months
 - b. Size range between 15 to 50 square meters, including bathroom and kitchen facilities and option to divide in 1 or 2 bedroom units
 - c. Hurricane category 5 resistant
 - d. Units must have a life-span of 15-20+ years
 - e. Optional:
 - i. Options for sustainability/ energy efficiency
 - ii. Aesthetics
 - iii. Landscaping
4. Interested companies can submit information on their product, providing the following:
 - a. Type of housing units available; including drawings, pictures, product description
 - b. Means of installing
 - c. Time needed for shipping
 - d. Time needed for assembly until turn-key delivery
